



# **BRUNCH BILL**

**With the passage of SB 561 during the 2019 Legislative Session, effective June 8, 2019, in all counties in West Virginia, Sunday hours of operation are permitted at 10 am for Class A – on premises alcohol sales.**



**The County option previously in W. Va. Code §7-1-3ss is no longer in effect. Counties where a vote was held and 10 am sales did not pass will be able to go to 10 am Class A on-premises alcohol sales as authorized under state code effective June 8, 2019 in order to conduct Sunday hours of operation at 10 am.**

**As of July 1, 2019, any County wanting to hold a vote pursuant to the newly enacted W. Va. Code §7-1-3ss may do so with the purpose to return the Sunday hours of operation to 1 pm.**

**Class A on-premises retailers include licensed: private clubs, private resort hotels, private hotels, private golf courses, private 9-hole golf courses, taverns, private wine restaurants, private wine spas, private wine bed and breakfasts, private wine professional/college stadiums, fair and festivals, approved floorplan extensions and one day charitable events.**

**Distilleries, mini-distilleries, wineries, farm wineries and resident brewers may conduct complimentary on-premises sampling at 10 am On Sunday, but no bottle sales (when licensed appropriately) until 1 pm.**
