Pursuant to WV Code §11-16-11b and §60-8-3(p), the undersigned nonprofit organization requests permission to sell and/or serve **wine and nonintoxicating beer** at the following fund-raising event for raising money for athletic, charitable, educational or religious purposes. The applicant must be the 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and must be the sole organization operating and managing the charitable event. **Please note that only six event licenses (6 days) may be issued to any single licensee during any calendar year.**

Third party organizers or Party Planners may not be compensated to operate or manage the event. Caterers may provide food services only, but may not purchase, sell or serve wine or nonintoxicating beer. The License holder, their employees or their bona fide volunteers must conduct all sales, furnishing, tendering and serving at the event.

Please return **form**, copies of the **501 (c)(3) nonprofit organization** documentation, and **floor plan** for approval consideration.

***If located within a municipality that has an open container ordinance, you must obtain a waiver from the municipality and submit the waiver with this form.**
