MONONGALIA COUNTY BAR AND RESTAURANT ADVISORY

(Effective July 14, 2020 through July 24, 2020, unless otherwise extended or amended)

Per the Governor's Executive Order 52-20 effective July 14, 2020), by further order of the Governor, Monongalia County bars and bar areas in restaurants are closed.

Monongalia County Bars may be open for take-away food, if they are providing freshly prepared food. Food may not be served from the bar and patrons may not sit or stand at the bar for any reason.

Monongalia County Restaurants may not serve food or alcohol from any bar area but may allow socially distant indoor seating/dining (50% of capacity) in a bar area, subject to other guidelines on indoor and outdoor seating/dining. Patrons should not be permitted to congregate in the bar area or around the bar. Restaurants may continue with take-away food service. Food may not be served from the bar and patrons may not sit or stand at the bar for any reason.

Further, per the Governor's Executive Order 51-20 – statewide, no live entertainment, such as a band, concert, singer, karaoke or adult exotic entertainment, is permitted at a Licensee's licensed premises (See Revised Advisory).

Also per EO 51-20 – statewide, carnivals, fairs, festivals, concert and music halls, outdoor concerts and adult entertainment venues shall be closed (See Revised Advisory).

Lastly, all licensees should comply with the Governor's mandatory mask requirements for staff and patrons, as applicable.
