MONONGALIA COUNTY BAR AND RESTAURANT ADVISORY – REVISED – 8/13/20

(EFFECTIVE AUGUST 13, 2020 THROUGH AUGUST 20, 2020, UNLESS OTHERWISE EXTENDED OR AMENDED)

Per the Governor's Executive Order 60-20 executed August 12, 2020, by further order of the Governor:

Monongalia County Bars shall not allow on-premises consumption of food or drink or occupancy by the general public for purposes other than picking up food and/or drink (as licensed, and as permitted under the law and Executive Orders) from such establishment to be taken away.

Monongalia County Restaurants (hotels and other similar licensed facilities) may sell and serve freshly prepared food and alcohol (when licensed) at tables, seats and bar tops within "bar areas" when dining, and also throughout the rest of the facility when dining, all subject to the 50% capacity requirement, social distance, and other guidelines on indoor and outdoor seating/dining and indoor/outdoor entertainment. Patrons should not be permitted to sit, stand or congregate in the bar area or around the bar or bar top when not dining. Restaurants (hotels and other similar licensed facilities) may continue with take-away food service.

Lastly, all licensees should comply with the Governor's mandatory mask requirements for staff and patrons, as applicable.
