MONONGALIA COUNTY BAR AND RESTAURANT ADVISORY – REVISED – 8/31/20 (EFFECTIVE AUGUST 31, 2020, UNLESS AMENDED)



Per the Governor's Executive Order 62-20 entered on August 19, 2020 and the Governor's Supplemental Protocols for Reopening Monongalia County Bars issued August 19, 2020 -

In order to resume operations on August 31, 2020, bars and bar areas within restaurants, hotels, and other similar facilities, licensees shall:

- Strictly enforce a maximum indoor occupancy of 50% of seating capacity;
- Restrict entrance to those who are 21 years of age or older;
- Close and restrict access to dance floors; and
- Prohibit any indoor live performance or entertainment.

Licensee's must take all necessary steps, including adding additional staff (if needed), in order to adhere to the 50% seating capacity requirement, social distance, mask and other guidelines on indoor and outdoor seating/dining and indoor/outdoor entertainment. Restaurants (hotels and other similar licensed facilities) may continue with take-away food service.

Lastly, all licensees should comply with the Governor's mandatory mask requirements for staff and patrons, as applicable.
