WVABCA RETAIL LIQUOR OUTLET ADVISORY

There is an influx of out-of-state and in-state people purchasing liquor in West Virginia.

- The WVABCA advises all retail liquor outlets to practice social distancing and limit the number of people congregating in any retail liquor outlet for the public's safety and your safety.
- Further, if you find that individuals are purchasing large quantities of liquor, it would be in your best interest to limit quantities per individual, perhaps to 3 - 4 bottles per person. This will also ensure enough liquor for all your patrons.
- Be advised some retailers are installing Plexiglass separation shields between their employees and patrons.
- Please follow all federal and state guidelines related to Covid-19.
